## School-Based Mental Health Services

School-Based Mental Health services collaborate with school personnel to combine academic, behavior, and mental health supports to children in an effort to increase the likelihood that you will have access to and benefit from mental health interventions.

What Do School-Based Mental Health Services Address? Licensed mental health professionals address behaviors that interfere with educational and social functioning such as...

- **School-Related Behaviors** - Suspension, truancy, failing grades, comprehension.
- **Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder**- Easily distracted, poor focus and concentration, fidgety, excessive talking.
- **Anxiety**- Excessive worry and fears, chronic stress.
- **Disruptive Mood Dysregulation Disorder**- Severe temper outburst, verbal and/or physical aggression.
- **Major Depressive Disorder**- Depressed mood, self-harm, suicidal thoughts.
- **Oppositional Defiant/Conduct Disorder**- Anger and irritability, non-compliance, threatening, bullying, intimidating, disregard of rules and boundaries.
